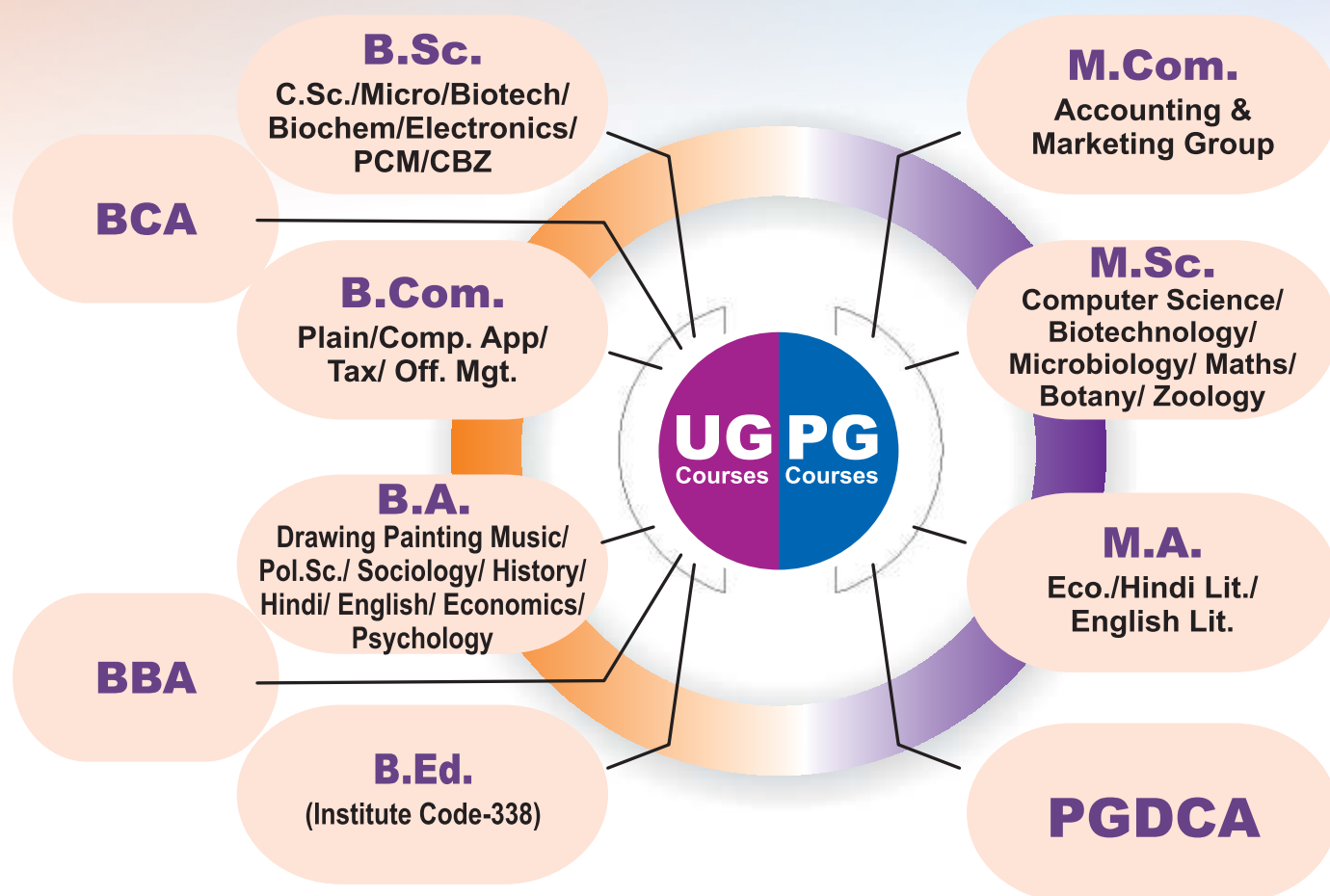
Hostel

Examination Pattern/Policy

- Semester pattern has been implemented for UG course from the year 2023.
- Every Student must attend her Offline classes regularly.
- Students who have attended 75 % of the classes will be eligible to appear in the Examinations.
- It is compulsory for all the students to appear in the Internal assessment/ CCE/ CVV/ Skill Development/ Internship & Projects. Since the marks are recorded in the Annual semester exam mark sheet. A Student absent / failing in the internal assessment/ CCE shall be treated as Supplementary/ATKT candidate.

- The candidates securing less than 12 valid credits in a semester exam has to repeat that semester and will not be promoted to the next semester.'
- Under Semester Pattern (UG Program) including National Education Policy (NEP) 2020 (CBCS) : Students with supplementary will have to appear in supplementary examinations which would be conducted within two months of result

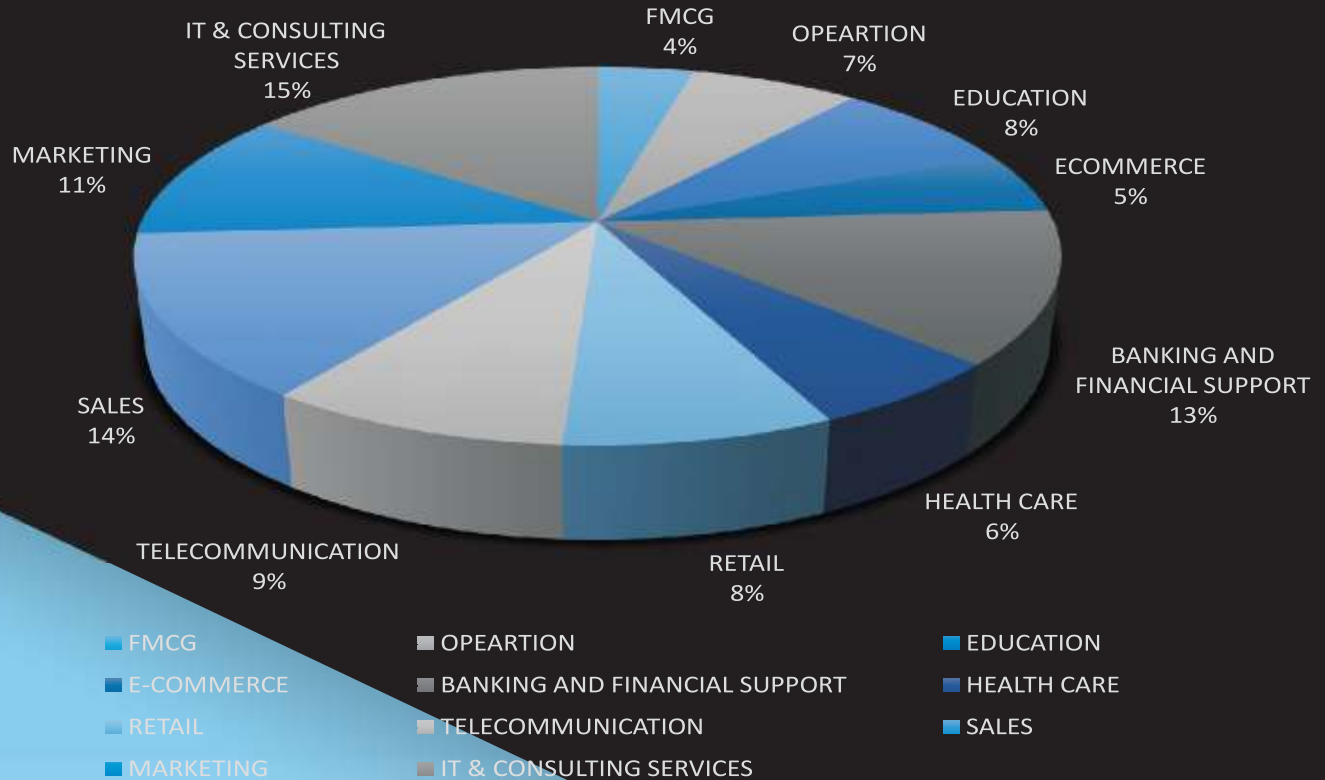
